9 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
10 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-125, as last amended
11 by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
12 2018, Section 2-125), which relates to the deposit
13 and expenditure of funds; allowing county sheriffs to
14 collect certain fees; directing where collected fees
15 shall be deposited; specifying use of received fees;
16 and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-125, as
19 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
20 2018, Section 2-125), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 2-125. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall assess
22 and collect costs and fees from subscribers to the Oklahoma Law
23 Enforcement Telecommunication System, to be deposited in the State
24 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Public Safety Restricted
Revolving Fund. Such costs and fees expended from the fund shall be
for personnel, recurring user fees, necessary hardware and

1 accessories, installation of equipment, maintenance and operational
2 expenses for the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System.
3 If a county sheriff offers hosting services, the sheriff may assess
4 and collect costs and fees from any such agency to be deposited in
5 the Sheriff's Service Fee Account. Such costs and fees expended
6 from the account shall be for personnel, recurring user fees,
7 necessary hardware and accessories, installation of equipment,
8 maintenance and operational expenses for the hosting system.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
