9 An Act relating to insurance; requiring Oklahoma  
10 Health Care Authority to seek waiver authority;  
11 providing for free oral and dental care for certain  
12 persons; providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.16 of Title 56, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek necessary federal  
19 authority through the appropriate waiver or state plan amendment to  
20 restore oral health care coverage for pregnant women over twenty-one  
21 (21) years of age. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall  
22 encourage these women to seek treatment prior to delivery. The  
23 SoonerCare benefit shall include exams, needed images, periodontal  
24 treatments and restorative procedures currently available to persons

1 under twenty-one (21) years of age. The covered benefit shall  
2 remain available for a minimum of sixty (60) days but shall not  
3 exceed twelve (12) months following the end of the pregnancy.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
