11 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Rate Preservation Fund;
13 creating the Rate Preservation Fund; designating the
14 nature of the fund; declaring fund monies
15 appropriated; providing and limiting purpose of
16 expenditure; requiring certain expenditure and
17 budgetary procedures; authorizing certain transfers;
18 and declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5020A of Title 63, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund for the
24 Oklahoma Health Care Authority to be designated the "Rate
Preservation Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not

1 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of monies
2 designated to the fund by law. All monies accruing to the credit of
3 the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by
4 the Authority for the sole purpose of maintaining reimbursement
5 rates to providers when decreases in the state's Federal Medical
6 Assistance Percentage (FMAP) rate would otherwise result in
7 implementation of reimbursement rate decreases by the Authority.
8 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
9 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
10 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
11 approval and payment. The Administrator of the Authority may
12 request the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
13 Services to transfer monies between the Rate Preservation Fund and
14 any other fund of the Authority as needed for the expenditure of
15 funds.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
