10 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care  
12 Authority; directing the Authority to revise certain  
13 methodology and to modify compensation; providing for  
14 duties and compensation of employees; authorizing  
15 payment of certain expenses; authorizing certain  
16 transfers; requiring certain transfers; authorizing  
17 certain early transfer requests; authorizing the  
18 exemption of unanticipated federal funds from  
19 expenditure and budgetary limitations; providing  
20 procedures; requiring certain budget procedures;  
21 prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing  
22 lapse dates.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall revise the  
payment methodology for hospital-based rural health care clinics.  
This revision shall increase payments to maximize the federal match.

1 SECTION 2. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall revise the  
2 methodology of the Disproportionate Share Hospital program.

3 SECTION 3. A. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law shall be set by the  
6 Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

7 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to:

8 1. Pay professional expenses of the Administrator of the  
9 Authority, including dues, licenses, professional memberships and  
10 continuing education classes conducted in the State of Oklahoma; and

11 2. Pay professional expenses of any employee, including dues,  
12 licenses, professional memberships, continuing medical education  
13 classes conducted in the State of Oklahoma and medical malpractice  
14 insurance; provided, he or she is a full-time employee of the  
15 Authority in accordance with subsection B of Section 5006 of Title  
16 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes or paragraph 1 of subsection B of  
17 Section 840-5.5 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes and utilizing  
18 those professional skills in the performance of his or her job  
19 duties.

20 SECTION 4. In order to facilitate cash management of federal  
21 grant receipts and disbursements, the Office of Management and  
22 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies between the Oklahoma  
23 Health Care Authority federal and revolving funds in amounts  
24 requested by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

1 SECTION 5. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to  
2 transfer funds from Fund 205 to Fund 340 to satisfy claims made to  
3 the Authority under the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment Program  
4 Act.

5 SECTION 6. A. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care  
6 Authority may request, in the manner provided in this section, that  
7 receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded after  
8 July 1, 2020, be exempt from expenditure limitations and from  
9 budgetary limitations.

10 1. The Administrator shall make a request for exemption to the  
11 Office of Management and Enterprise Services in writing and file a  
12 revised budget program.

13 2. The Administrator shall also file copies of the request for  
14 exemption and budget work program revisions with the Oklahoma House  
15 of Representatives Appropriations and Budget Committee Chair and the  
16 Oklahoma State Senate Appropriations Committee Chair. The House  
17 Appropriations and Budget Committee Chair and/or the Senate  
18 Appropriations Committee Chair shall notify the Office of Management  
19 and Enterprise Services of any noncompliance of the request with  
20 legislative intent within twelve (12) calendar days of their receipt  
21 of the exemption request.

22 B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall  
23 approve the request for exemption unless both the Chair and Vice  
24 Chair of the Joint Legislative Committee on Budget and Program

1 Oversight provide written notification to the Office of Management  
2 and Enterprise Services within twelve (12) calendar days of the  
3 Committee's receipt of the exemption request that the exemption  
4 subverts the intention and objectives of the Legislature in  
5 establishing the original limit. The Office of Management and  
6 Enterprise Services shall give written notice of approval or  
7 disapproval of each exemption to the agency, the Governor, the Chair  
8 of the House Appropriations and Budget Committee and the Chair of  
9 the Senate Appropriations Committee within eighteen (18) calendar  
10 days of receiving the request.

11 SECTION 7. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services  
12 shall transfer monies appropriated from the General Revenue Fund and  
13 the 245 Fund to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority disbursing funds  
14 in the amounts and ratios requested by the Authority, except that  
15 the cumulative amount transferred shall not exceed the cumulative  
16 amount of equal monthly allotments of the appropriation from the  
17 General Revenue Fund. Monies appropriated or collected for the  
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, may be transferred to these  
19 disbursing funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to  
20 satisfy encumbrances and obligations of said fiscal year; provided,  
21 that monies equal in amount are transferred from appropriations or  
22 collections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to the  
23 disbursing fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to satisfy  
24 encumbrances and obligations of said fiscal year. All transfer

1 requests shall be in writing to the Office of Management and  
2 Enterprise Services. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall  
3 maintain record of the inter-year transfers.

4 SECTION 8. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care  
5 Authority may request, through the Director of the Office of  
6 Management and Enterprise Services, the early transfer by the  
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue  
8 Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the agency's disbursing  
9 funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

10 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922  
11 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including  
12 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21) or may be  
14 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22).  
15 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
16 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds  
17 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall  
18 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
19 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June  
20 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse  
21 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
22 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
23 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21, and not required to pay  
24 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-22, after

1 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
2 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
3 from the FY-21 budget work program and after such revision has been  
4 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
