11 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health
13 and Substance Abuse Services; requiring that portions
14 of certain appropriated funds be used for certain
15 purposes; creating pilot programs; authorizing
16 request for early transfers of certain funds for
17 specific purpose; providing for lapse of funds under
18 certain conditions; requiring certain budget
19 procedures; and prohibiting certain budget
20 procedures.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
23 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
24 No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the

1 sum of Two Million Seven Hundred Twenty-six Thousand Fifty-nine
2 Dollars (\$2,726,059.00) shall be used for program growth.

3 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
4 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
5 No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the
6 sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used for
7 suicide prevention. These funds shall be used for providing
8 services which would otherwise be eliminated by reduction of federal
9 funding.

10 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
11 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
12 No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the
13 sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to
14 establish and maintain five pilot programs to provide offenders
15 incarcerated in county jails in the State of Oklahoma access to
16 Federal-Drug-Administration-approved, evidence-based, medication-
17 assisted treatment for opioid and alcohol dependence. Treatment may
18 be administered while the inmate is confined in the county jail and
19 when participating in outpatient care upon release. Funding may
20 only be used for medical evaluations, the purchase of Federal-Drug-
21 Administration-approved medication to treat opioid or alcohol
22 dependency, individual and group counseling services, cognitive
23 behavioral therapies and necessary medical and behavioral health
24 staff needed to implement the program.

1 SECTION 4. The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health
2 and Substance Abuse Services may request through the Director of the
3 Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by
4 the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General
5 Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's
6 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

7 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922
8 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
9 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21) or may be
11 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22).
12 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30,
13 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds
14 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall
15 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
16 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June
17 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse
18 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
19 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
20 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21, and not required to pay
21 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-22, after
22 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
23 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
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1 from the FY-21 budget work program and after such revision has been
2 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
