10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the District Courts; redesignating
12 certain funds; requiring that portions of certain
13 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes;
14 providing lapse dates; and requiring and prohibiting
15 certain budget procedures.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION The amount of Three Million Dollars
18 (\$3,000,000.00) appropriated to the Supreme Court from the Opioid
19 Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury in Section
20 130 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the 57th
21 Oklahoma Legislature is hereby redesignated to the District Courts
22 or so much thereof as may be necessary to address the impact of
23 opioids on the state and its residents.

24 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 130 of Enrolled
Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma

1 Legislature, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be used by
2 the District Courts for purposes including but not limited to drug
3 courts, mental health courts, and veteran courts.

4 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922
5 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
6 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21), or may be
8 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22).
9 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30,
10 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds
11 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall
12 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal
13 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June
14 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse
15 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year.
16 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
17 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21, and not required to pay
18 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-22, after
19 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
20 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
21 from the FY-21 budget work program and after such revision has been
22 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
