7 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
8 requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds
9 be used for certain purposes; stating purpose of
10 certain disbursement; requiring the use of certain
11 data; directing the Department to develop method of
12 disbursement; authorizing promulgation of rules;
13 authorizing requests for early transfers of certain
14 funds for specific purposes; providing for lapse of
15 funds under certain conditions; requiring certain
16 budget procedures; and prohibiting certain budget
17 procedures.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
20 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
21 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars
22 (\$50,000.00) shall be used for increased sickle cell outreach.

23 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
24 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
(\$100,000.00) shall be used for the operations of the Oklahoma

1 Athletic Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma
2 State Athletic Commission Act.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
4 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
5 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Dollars
6 (\$2,000,000.00) shall be used for the continuation of the Choosing
7 Childbirth Act by the provisions listed in Section 1-740.15 et seq.
8 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
10 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
11 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Four Hundred Sixty-three
12 Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$463,670.00) shall be used for
13 the operation of the Dental Loan Repayment Program.

14 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
15 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
16 57th Oklahoma Legislature, One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars
17 (\$1,900,000.00) shall be disbursed to health centers authorized
18 under Section 330 of the Public Health Services Act, and
19 incorporated in the State of Oklahoma. Any disbursement shall be
20 for the purpose of increasing access to primary health care which
21 may include medical, dental, and or mental health and substance
22 abuse treatment services in or near designated Medically Underserved
23 Areas or Medically Underserved Populations. Any disbursement for
24 increased access to primary health care services shall be supported

1 by data according to proportions of patient volume and access for
2 uninsured. The method of disbursement shall be developed by the
3 State Department of Health. The State Commissioner of Health is
4 authorized to promulgate the method of disbursement into rules.

5 SECTION 6. The Commissioner of the State Department of Health
6 may request through the Director of the Office of Management and
7 Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax
8 Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the
9 purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to
10 alleviate cash-flow problems.

11 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922
12 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature not including
13 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21), or may be
15 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22).
16 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30,
17 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds
18 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall
19 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal
20 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June
21 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse
22 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year.
23 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
24 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21, and not required to pay
