16 Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature shall approve in whole or in  
17 part, disapprove in whole or in part or amend in whole or in part  
18 subject matter standards adopted by the State Board of Education and  
19 submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives or a  
20 designee and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate or a designee  
21 for legislative review; and

22 WHEREAS, on March 2, 2020, the State Board of Education  
23 submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the

1 President Pro Tempore of the Senate the adopted Oklahoma Academic  
2 Standards for Science and Oklahoma Academic Standards for Fine Arts.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
4 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

7 of Education and submitted to the Speaker of the House of  
8 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate on March  
9 2, 2020, are hereby approved in whole.

10 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to  
11 distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor and the editor
