9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to livestock products; authorizing
11 the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to
12 implement certain standards to market and sell beef
and bison products under certain conditions;
13 authorizing the Department to promulgate certain
rules regarding slaughter facilities; requiring that
14 promulgated rules will not compromise safety;
providing for codification; and declaring an
15 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-182.1 of Title 2, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Upon approval by the United States Department of
22 Agriculture, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and

1 Forestry may establish standards for Oklahoma producers that market
2 and sell beef and bison in intrastate commerce.

3 B. The Department is authorized to promulgate rules regarding
4 slaughter facilities that provide for the following:

5 1. Establish standards that allow for flexibility in beef and
6 bison inspection, including but not limited to, establishing the
7 number of inspectors at a facility and the use of technologies to
8 digitally inspect meat;

9 2. Establish standards for the labeling of beef and bison
10 products sold intrastate;

11 3. Establish standards for the number of head over which a
12 facility shall pay for a state inspector; and

13 4. Establish any other standards necessary to increase the
14 ability of producers to market and sell beef and bison in intrastate
15 commerce.

16 C. Any rules promulgated pursuant to this section shall ensure
17 that food safety will not be compromised in any way and will ensure
18 that consumers are protected.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
