10 An Act relating to Unmanned Aircraft Systems;  
11 defining term; allowing for registry of state  
12 government unmanned aircraft systems; providing for  
13 codification; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 371 of Title 3, unless there is  
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. As used in this section:

20 1. "Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft, as defined in Section  
21 82 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes, that is operated without the  
22 possibility of human intervention from within or on the aircraft;  
23 and

1           2. "Unmanned aircraft system" means an unmanned aircraft and  
2 associated elements, including communication links and components  
3 that control the unmanned aircraft that are required for the pilot  
4 in command to operate safely and efficiently in the national  
5 airspace system.

6           B. It is hereby created within the Oklahoma Aeronautics  
7 Commission, a central registry of unmanned aircraft systems and  
8 operators within state agencies. The registry will provide a  
9 central repository of information to assist with integrating  
10 unmanned aircraft systems and provide resources for the needs of  
11 state agencies that have a desire to utilize this technology  
12 throughout the state.

13           1. State agencies that operate unmanned aircraft systems shall  
14 provide data on the type of system being utilized by the agency, FAA  
15 registration information, operators/pilots of the system and any  
16 other information that may be useful in the registry.

17           2. Public educational institutions that offer training programs  
18 for users of unmanned aircraft systems shall provide data on the  
19 type of training being offered, the system being utilized in the  
20 training, instructors for the training program and/or operators of  
21 the system being utilized in the training, FAA registration  
22 information and any other information that may be useful in the  
23 registry.

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1 C. The Commission is authorized to promulgate any rules  
2 necessary to implement this registry.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
