7                                   AS INTRODUCED

8                   An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; making  
9                   certain felons eligible for certain license under  
10                  certain conditions after certain period; prohibiting  
11                  certain licensing of felons with convictions of  
12                  certain crimes; providing for codification; and  
13                  providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
16           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-145A of Title 37A, unless  
17           there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18           A.   Except as provided in subsection B of this section, a prior  
19           felony conviction shall not disqualify an individual from applying  
20           for, receiving and renewing an employee license authorized by  
21           Section 2-121 of Title 37A of the Oklahoma Statutes if:

22           1.   The person meets all other qualifications and requirements  
23           for obtaining and maintaining the license; and

1        2. The person has not been convicted of any felony within three  
2 (3) years of the application date.

3        B. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall  
4 refuse to issue an employee license authorized by Section 2-121 of  
5 Title 37A of the Oklahoma Statutes, either on an original  
6 application or a renewal application, if it has reasonable grounds  
7 to believe and finds the applicant has a prior conviction for any of  
8 the following felony offenses:

9            1. An alcohol-related offense;

10           2. A violent crime as defined in Section 142A-1 of Title 21 of  
11 the Oklahoma Statutes; or

12           3. A crime which would subject a person to registration  
13 pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act.

14        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
