3 B. The Two-Dollar raise as provided for in subsection A of this
4 section shall be reduced for personnel of the Department of
5 Corrections by an amount proportional to the raise that was received
6 pursuant to Enrolled House Bill No. 2771 of the 1st Session of the
7 57th Oklahoma Legislature.
