



1 that control the unmanned aircraft that are required for the pilot  
2 in command to operate safely and efficiently in the national  
3 airspace system.

4 B. It is hereby created within the Oklahoma Aeronautics  
5 Commission, a central registry of unmanned aircraft systems and  
6 operators within state agencies. The registry will provide a  
7 central repository of information to assist with integrating  
8 unmanned aircraft systems and provide resources for the needs of  
9 state agencies that have a desire to utilize this technology  
10 throughout the state.

11 1. State agencies that operate unmanned aircraft systems shall  
12 provide data on the type of system being utilized by the agency, FAA  
13 registration information, operators/pilots of the system and any  
14 other information that may be useful in the registry.

15 2. Public educational institutions that offer training programs  
16 for users of unmanned aircraft systems shall provide data on the  
17 type of training being offered, the system being utilized in the  
18 training, instructors for the training program and/or operators of  
19 the system being utilized in the training, FAA registration  
20 information and any other information that may be useful in the  
21 registry.

22 C. The Commission is authorized to promulgate any rules  
23 necessary to implement this registry.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

1       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
