10 B. The membership of the ~~Board~~ board shall be composed of five
11 ~~(5)~~ members appointed by the city council of such city, or city
12 commission, whichever applies, and four members appointed by the
13 board of county commissioners of such county. Each member shall
14 serve a term of six (6) years, except, that of the members initially
15 appointed by the city council, or city commission, whichever
16 applies, one member initially appointed shall serve a term of two
17 (2) years, one member initially appointed shall serve a term of
18 three (3) years, one member initially appointed shall serve a term
19 of four (4) years, one member initially appointed shall serve a term
20 of five (5) years, and one member initially appointed shall serve a
21 term of six (6) years; provided, however, that in any such city
22 having a city board of health created under its charter provisions,
23 the members of such city board of health and the tenure of the city
24 board of health members of the city-county board of health shall be

1 coterminous with the city board of health. Of the members initially
2 appointed by the board of county commissioners, one member initially
3 appointed shall serve a term of two (2) years, one member initially
4 appointed shall serve a term of three (3) years, one member
5 initially appointed shall serve a term of five (5) years, and one
6 member initially appointed shall serve a term of six (6) years. The
7 appointing authority shall appoint new members as the terms of
8 office of its initial appointees expire. Wherever a city-county
9 board of health is now in existence, the current board members shall
10 be retained, until the termination of their present appointment, by
11 the appointing authorities.

12 C. A county board of health in any county of this state with a
13 population of more than two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000),
14 but not more than five hundred thousand (500,000), according to the
15 latest Federal Decennial Census, may create a city-county board of
16 health as provided in this section composed of members as provided
17 by Section 1-201 of this title.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
