6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.25, as last
9 amended by Section 4, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59
10 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1000.25), which relates to
11 construction permit fees; eliminating certain
12 building permit fees; and providing an effective
13 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.25, as
16 last amended by Section 4, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.
17 2018, Section 1000.25), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1000.25 A. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code
19 Commission shall establish a system of fees to be charged for the
20 issuance and renewal of any construction permits issued by any
21 agency, municipality, or other political subdivision of this state.

22 B. This provision is subject to the following limitations:

23 1. No schedule of fees may be established or amended by the
24 Commission except during such times as the Legislature is in
session; provided, the Commission may establish or amend a schedule
of fees at a time when the Legislature is not in session if the fees

1 or schedule of fees has been specifically authorized by the
2 Legislature pursuant to ~~paragraphs~~ paragraph 2 and 3 of this
3 subsection. The Commission must follow the procedures required by
4 Article I of the Administrative Procedures Act for adoption of rules
5 in establishing or amending any such schedule of fees;

6 ~~2. The Commission shall charge fees for building permits and~~
7 ~~renewal of such permits issued by any state agency, municipality, or~~
8 ~~other political subdivision of this state which authorized work~~
9 ~~governed by codes within the purview of the Commission only within~~
10 ~~the following ranges:~~

11 ~~For issuance of permit not to exceed \$5.00~~

12 ~~For renewal of permit not to exceed \$5.00~~

13 ~~Fees shall be remitted to the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code~~
14 ~~Commission within thirty (30) days after the end of the preceding~~
15 ~~calendar month. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission shall~~
16 ~~report to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the~~
17 ~~Speaker of the House semiannually its collections for the six (6)~~
18 ~~months preceding the report;~~

19 ~~3.~~ Fees shall be collected by any state agency, municipality or
20 other political subdivision issuing construction permits within this
21 state. The fees shall be deposited in an account created by the
22 collecting entity for that purpose;

23 ~~4.~~ 3. The state agency, municipality or other political
24 subdivision shall remit the monies in the account on a monthly basis

1 directly to the State Treasury for deposit in the Oklahoma Uniform
2 Building Code Commission Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section
3 1000.28 of this title. Along with the deposits required by this
4 paragraph, each state agency, municipality or other political
5 subdivision shall also submit a report stating the total amount of
6 funds collected and the total number of fees imposed during the
7 preceding month. The report shall be made on computerized or manual
8 disposition reports as provided by rule of the Commission;

9 ~~5.~~ 4. Any state agency, municipality or other political
10 subdivision collecting and remitting fees pursuant to this section
11 may levy a fee up to fifty cents (\$0.50) for every construction
12 permit or renewal permit issued. These monies shall be deposited
13 into an account for the sole use of the state agency, municipality
14 or other political subdivision. The state agency, municipality or
15 other political subdivision shall state the total amount of funds
16 collected and the total number of fees imposed to the State Treasury
17 in the report required by paragraph ~~4~~ 3 of this subsection;

18 ~~6.~~ 5. It shall be the responsibility of the state agency,
19 municipality or other political subdivision to account for and
20 ensure the correctness and accuracy of payments made to the State
21 Treasury pursuant to this title;

22 ~~7.~~ 6. Funds collected by a state agency, municipality or other
23 political subdivision and remitted to the State Treasury pursuant to
24 the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission Act shall be deposited

1 in the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission Revolving Fund and
2 shall be used solely for the purposes of the Oklahoma Uniform
3 Building Code Commission Act; and

4 ~~8.~~ 7. Nothing in this act shall prevent the Oklahoma Uniform
5 Building Code Commission from offering incentives for prompt
6 payment.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
