6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 840-2.16, which relates to state  
9 employee salary; modifying minimum annualized salary;  
10 and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 840-2.16, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 840-2.16 Except as otherwise provided by law, any  
15 ~~classified, unclassified or exempt~~ employee of the state, excluding  
16 members of boards and commissions, institutions under the  
17 administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher  
18 Education, employees of public school districts and elected  
19 officials, on July 1 ~~of each year,~~ 2020, earning less than ~~the~~  
20 ~~amount established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a three-~~  
21 ~~person household, issued each year in the Federal Register by the~~  
22 ~~United States Department of Health and Human Services~~ Fifteen  
23 Dollars (\$15.00) per hour, shall receive the necessary grade or  
24 salary adjustment to provide for a minimum annualized salary equal

1 to the amount established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a  
2 three-person household, issued each year in the Federal Register by  
3 the United States Department of Health and Human Services Fifteen  
4 Dollars (\$15.00) per hour. Any classified, unclassified or exempt  
5 employee of the state, excluding members of boards and commissions,  
6 institutions under the administrative authority of the Oklahoma  
7 State Regents for Higher Education, employees of public school  
8 districts and elected officials, employed after July 1, ~~2007~~ 2020,  
9 shall receive a minimum annualized salary equal to ~~the amount~~  
10 ~~established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a three-person~~  
11 ~~household, issued each year in the Federal Register by the United~~  
12 ~~States Department of Health and Human Services Fifteen Dollars~~  
13 (\$15.00) per hour. This section shall not apply to those persons  
14 employed pursuant to paragraph 8 and paragraph 12 of subsection A of  
15 Section 840-5.5 and Section 2241 of this title or those persons  
16 employed pursuant to Section 1.6a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
