6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to private vocational schools;
8 requiring accountability for student performance on
9 national certification exams; mandating compliance
10 with regulations and requirements of certification
11 entities; directing revocation of license for failure
12 to comply; prescribing Oklahoma Board of Private
13 Vocational Schools to promulgate rules; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-120 of Title 70, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Every private school as defined in Section 21-101.1 of Title
20 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and licensed by the Oklahoma Board of
21 Private Vocational Schools shall be held accountable for student
22 performance on national certification exams and shall ensure
23 compliance with the regulations and requirements of the appropriate
24 vocational certification entity.

1 B. The license of a private school which fails to comply with
2 the provisions of subsection A of this section shall be revoked by
3 the Board after reasonable notice to the private school and an
4 opportunity to be heard.

5 C. The Board shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions
6 of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
