11 An Act relating to the Office of Management and
12 Enterprise Services; requiring that portions of
13 certain appropriated funds be used for certain
14 purposes; and requiring utilization in certain
15 manner.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
18 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922
19 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One
20 Million Nine Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$1,920,000.00) shall
21 be used to provide for the Pay for Success program. Of that amount,
22 seventy-five percent (75%) shall be utilized by the Office in equal
23 amounts for municipalities of the state with populations of three
24

1 hundred fifty thousand (350,000) or more as determined by the latest
2 Federal Decennial Census.
