10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
12 requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds
13 be used for certain purposes; stating purpose of
14 certain disbursement; requiring the use of certain
15 data; directing the Department to develop method of
16 disbursement; authorizing promulgation of rules;
17 authorizing requests for early transfers of certain
18 funds for specific purposes; providing for lapse of
19 funds under certain conditions; requiring certain
20 budget procedures; and prohibiting certain budget
21 procedures.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
24 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars
(\$50,000.00) shall be used for increased sickle cell outreach.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
2 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
3 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
4 (\$100,000.00) shall be used for the operations of the Oklahoma
5 Athletic Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma
6 State Athletic Commission Act.

7 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
8 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
9 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Dollars
10 (\$2,000,000.00) shall be used for the continuation of the Choosing
11 Childbirth Act by the provisions listed in Section 1-740.15 et seq.
12 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

13 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
14 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
15 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Four Hundred Sixty-three
16 Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$463,670.00) shall be used for
17 the operation of the Dental Loan Repayment Program.

18 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
19 of Health in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the 2nd Session of the
20 57th Oklahoma Legislature, One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars
21 (\$1,900,000.00) shall be disbursed to health centers authorized
22 under Section 330 of the Public Health Services Act, and
23 incorporated in the State of Oklahoma. Any disbursement shall be
24 for the purpose of increasing access to primary health care which

1 may include medical, dental, and or mental health and substance
2 abuse treatment services in or near designated Medically Underserved
3 Areas or Medically Underserved Populations. Any disbursement for
4 increased access to primary health care services shall be supported
5 by data according to proportions of patient volume and access for
6 uninsured. The method of disbursement shall be developed by the
7 State Department of Health. The State Commissioner of Health is
8 authorized to promulgate the method of disbursement into rules.

9 SECTION 6. The Commissioner of the State Department of Health
10 may request through the Director of the Office of Management and
11 Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax
12 Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the
13 purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to
14 alleviate cash-flow problems.

15 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922
16 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature not including
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21), or may be
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22).
20 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30,
21 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds
22 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June

1 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year.
3 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21, and not required to pay
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-22, after
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
8 from the FY-21 budget work program and after such revision has been
9 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
