Research Analysis

HB 1030 provides that a prior felony conviction does not disqualify an individual from obtaining an employee license from the ABLE Commission if the person meets all other qualifications and the person has not been convicted of any felony within three years of application for the license. An employee license may be refused if ABLE determines that the applicant has a prior felony conviction for an alcohol related offense, a violent crime or a crime which would subject the person to register as a sex offender.
