Research Analysis

HB1034, as committee substitute, relates to coverage for individuals with autism. The measure increases eligibility for coverage for screening, diagnosis, and treatment of autism spectrum disorder for individuals less than 18 years old, raising the age limit from 9 years old. The measure also removes the six-year period for coverage if diagnosis occurred after the age of three.
