Research Analysis

FA1 to HB 1038 provides that the Office of Management and Enterprise Services is required to develop job descriptions and a compensation schedule for all full-time court reporters regularly engaged by the district courts, the Worker's Compensation Court of Existing Claims and the Corporation Commission who are certified shorthand reporters. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is to establish and publish the compensation schedules by January 1, 2020.

Fiscal Analysis

The FA1 on HB 1038 stipulates that OMES develop job descriptions and a compensation schedule for all full-time court reporters for the district courts (75 court reporters), the Worker's Compensation Court of Existing Claims (3) and the Corporation Commission (7) who are certified shorthand reporters. Upon review, it is determined that OMES can absorb any costs associated with this floor amendment.
