Research Analysis

HB1053, as introduced, relates to the Small Employer Health Insurance Reform Act. The measure removes the stipulation that associations be in existence for a minimum of 5 years in order to be classified as a bona fide association, or a large group, for the purposes of the this title. The measure further states that a bona fide association health plan may not exclude small employers with at least one eligible employee, lowering the minimum from two eligible employees.
