**Research Analysis**

The senate amendments to HB 1053 strike the title.

HB1053 replaces the definition for “bona fide association” and removes current provisions related to health benefit plans issued by bona fide associations. The measure redefines “bona fide association” as any Oklahoma association that has a current M-1 form filed with the U.S. Department of Labor. The measure requires that health plans issued by bona fide associations follow the delivery requirements as other group plans, comply with federal nondiscrimination requirements, and include employers with at least 2 eligible employees.
