Research Analysis

HB 1057, as introduced, enacts the Psychology Interjurisdictional Compact. This interstate compact regulates the practice of telepsychology, or provision of psychological services using telecommunication technologies across state lines. The compact also regulates temporary in-person practice of psychologists across state lines for 30 days in a calendar year, and authorizes state psychology regulatory authorities to recognize psychologists located in another state.
