**Research Analysis**

HB1226, as introduced, repeals the notice requirements for name change petition filings in civil procedures. Currently, the notice must be printed at least 10 days prior to the hearing in a local newspaper. Further, the measure repeals the stipulation that courts may waive notice requirements in cases of domestic violence.
