Research Analysis

HB 1265 creates definitions for Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 electric-assisted bicycles. The measure allows for the use of electric-assisted bicycles and exempts them from driver license, insurance requirements, vehicle registration and certificates of title.

The measure repeals Title 47, Section 11-805.2 relating to Operation of Electric-Assisted Bicycles

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1265 removes the requirement for those individuals operating electric-assisted bicycles to hold a driver license. The revenue impact is minimal to the state, as it is assumed the individuals operating these bikes will still acquire a driver license for operating other types of vehicles. The owners of these bikes already are not required to acquire a title or registration.
