The proposed committee substitute to HB 1294 provides that a defendant is to be brought to the court within 48 hours of being taken into custody and has a right to counsel at the initial appearance. The defendant shall be entitled to counsel at the arraignment and shall be provided a copy of the charge against him or her. The court shall schedule a preliminary hearing in applicable cases.
