**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB1316 requires school districts to provide no less than two days of training to emergency-certified teachers who do not already hold a standard certificate prior to them working in the classroom, and includes specific requirements for the training.

The proposed committee substitute requires the school district to provide emergency certified teachers with additional training throughout the year. The measure also requires the school principal to arrange a mentor to provide support, guidance and advice to the emergency-certified teacher on an ongoing basis.
