Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB1316 make changes the proposed training requirements for emergency certified teachers.

The amendments require an emergency certified teacher to complete no less than one day of professional development before entering the classroom if he or she is hired before the school year begins.

The amendments require a school district to provide an emergency certified teacher with six hours of professional development within their first two weeks in the classroom, if the teacher is hired after the school year begins.

The training is required to include professional development on classroom management and school policies and procedures. The employing school district is required to provide a mentor, and additional training to emergency certified teachers throughout the year.

If the districts incur additional costs, it is dependent upon the nature of the situation.
