**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1347 provides that a mixed beverage, on-premises or wine licensee is not in violation of their license if a patron leaves the premises with an open container if the act was committed on the day of a scheduled home football game and the establishment is located within 2,000 feet of an institution of higher education, or if the licensee is participating in a municipally sanctioned and sponsored single-day art or music event.
