Research Analysis

HB 1956, as introduced, clarifies the authority of the Construction Industries Board over persons performing building inspection work or holding themselves out as performing the work of building inspectors. The bill imposes a penalty, which may include an administrative fine, on any person acting or performing as a building or construction inspector without a proper license. The measure also requires a municipality of more than 10,000 to provide the board with a list of all building and construction inspectors it uses.
