**Research Analysis**

HB 2028 establishes a statutory deer gun and crossbow hunting season, which shall begin the Saturday before Thanksgiving and run for 21 days. The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation's administrative rules set deer gun season as the Saturday before Thanksgiving and lasts for 16 days; agency rules set deer archery season as October 1 through January 15.
