**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2373 provides that in any action for nuisance brought against agricultural activities on farm or ranch land, the court or jury is to determine the amount of noneconomic damages separately from the amount of compensation for all other damages and noneconomic damages awarded to a plaintiff are not to exceed three times the amount of compensatory damages or \$250,000, whichever amount is greater.
