Research Analysis

HB2649, as proposed committee substitute, directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek federal waivers or state plan amendments in order to provide oral health coverage for pregnant women over 21 years old. The coverage shall include exams, needed images, periodontal treatments, and restorative treatments. The benefit shall be available for a minimum of 60 days after pregnancy and a maximum of 12 months after pregnancy.
