Research Analysis

HB2669 creates a 9 member State Revenue Apportionment Evaluation Commission that is tasked with analyzing the state revenue system with special emphasis on the amount of revenue which is apportioned for purposes outside of the General Revenue Fund for each fiscal year. The measure requires the commission hold an organization meeting within 60 days of July 1, 2019 to select a chair and vice-chair and submit a report to the Governor and Legislature within 120 days after the end of each fiscal year.

The Speaker and the Senate Pro Tempore each have two appointees to the commission. The senate amendments to HB2669 requires the appointees of the Speaker and Senate Pro Tempore to be from the majority and minority party. The senate amendments also added a sunset date of July 1, 2023 for the commission.
