**Research Analysis**

HB 2791 requires every child 17 years of age or under to be properly secured while being transported in a motor vehicle. A child between the age of 8 and 12 years of age is to be properly secured in a child restraint system, belt-positioning booster seat or seat belt. A child who is 13 years of age or older is to be properly secured in a seat belt.
