Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB 2823 extends the sunset dates for the various entities that were set to sunset this year. The entities are extended until July, 2023. The entities extended are:

- 1) Board of Governors of the Licensed Architects, Landscape Architects and Registered Interior Designers of Oklahoma
- 2) State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors
- 3) State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners
- 4) Polygraph Examiners Board
- 5) Construction Industries Board
- 6) Oklahoma Accountancy Board
- 7) Oklahoma Funeral Board
- 8) Oklahoma Board of Licensed Social Workers
- 9) Board of Chiropractic Examiners
- 10) Oklahoma Board of Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors

- 13) Child Death Review Board within the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth
