Research Analysis

HB 2882 directs the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority to develop training standards for 9-1-1 call takers that include training program standards which include high-quality Telecommunicator CPR that can be provided by 9-1-1 call takers for acute events requiring CPR including; and follow evidence-based , nationally recognized guidelines for high-quality Telecommunicator CPR which incorporates recognition protocols for out-of-hospital cardiac arrest and continuous education.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2882 in its current form modifies the powers and duties of the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority, related to developing training program standards. Legal, administrative, fiscal and staff support for the Authority is provided by the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management, but expenses related to such services are reimbursable from the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority Revolving Fund. Any increase in administrative costs related to the provisions of this measure, which are not expected to be significant, are anticipated to be absorbed by such revolving funds. For this reason HB 2882 in its current form is not expected to impact the State's appropriated budget.
