**Research Analysis**

The SA to HB 2938 amend the circumstances under which records related to a public health investigation may be released. If the State Department of Health determines that releasing a patient's records is necessary to protect the public health, it may only do so if the release is authorized under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).
