Research Analysis

HB 3347, as introduced, prevents Oklahoma institutions of higher education and intercollegiate athletic associations from blocking student athletes from making money off the use of their name, image, or likeness. Institutions of higher education and athletic associations are also not allowed to prevent a student athlete from obtaining professional representation.

Earning compensation and obtaining professional representation as a student athlete shall not affect a student's scholarship eligibility.

HB 3347 prevents institutions within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and intercollegiate athletic association from providing prospective student athletes with compensation in relation to the student's name, image, or likeness.

Lastly, the measure prevents student athletes from entering in to a contract if it is in conflict with a provision of the athlete's team contract.
