**Research Analysis**

The PCS for HB 3806 defines “beef,” “beef product,” “pork,” and “pork product” and creates the Oklahoma Meat Consumer Protection Act, which aims to ensure clarity and accuracy in labeling or advertising of meat and plant-based food items and defines “meat.” The measure repeals sections in Title 63 that define and prohibit deceptive practices for labeling and selling meat or plant-derived meat alternatives.
