**Research Analysis**

The CS to HB 4064 replaces the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) with a newly created Division of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services under the administrative control of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA). OHCA and ODMHSAS are directed complete consolidation by June 30, 2020. OHCA is directed to administer programs and promulgate rules currently under the authority of ODMHSAS. Further, the measure removes all classified positions within OHCA. Lastly, the measure repeals sections related to the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.
