HJR 1020 sends to a vote of the people a proposed constitutional amendment that would, if approved, amend term limits by allowing individuals to serve up to 20 years total in the legislature; provided no more than 12 years could be served in either the House or Senate.

HJR 1020 in its current form, sends to a vote of the people a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution which would modify term limitations for legislators. The amendment has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or revenues.
