Fiscal Analysis

The measure is an amendment to HB4018, Section three (3). The bill allows for a change in the number of appointees to the Rural Broadband Expansion Council who will conduct a study of rural broadband access in the state. The amendment to the measure concerning the Council has no fiscal impact anticipated.

The Corporation Commission anticipates no fiscal impact to the agency.

Per the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, the use of the Digital Transformation Fund for staffing and the building of a website, will have a neutral fiscal impact to the agency.
