	Impact: Directs expenditures of the State Health Department

Research Analysis

SB 1058 directs the expenditure of certain appropriations to the Oklahoma State Department of Health. The bill:

- Directs \$50,000 authorized under SB 1922 to be used for increase sickle cell outreach,
- Directs \$100,000 authorized under SB 1922 to be used for operating the Oklahoma Athletic Commission,
- Directs \$2,000,000 authorized under SB 1922 to be used to carry out the Choosing Childbirth Act,
- Directs \$463,670 authorized under SB 1922 to be used for operating the Dental Loan Repayment Program,
- Directs \$1,900,000 authorized under SB 1922 to be disbursed to health centers authorized under the Public Health Services Act. Disbursement must be used to increase access to primary care in medically underserved areas and populations,
- Allows for appropriations authorized under SB 1922 to be budgeted for FY 2021 or FY 2022, and
- Authorizes OSDH to request early transfer of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund to allow for early allocation to OSDH's disbursing funds.

Fiscal Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 1058 requires certain portions of appropriated funds provided to the State Department of Health to be utilized in a manner proscribed by the measure. Funds are to be spent as follows:

- 1) \$50,000.00 for sickle cell outreach
- 2) \$100,000.00 for the operations of the Oklahoma Athletic Commission
- 3) \$2 million for the continuation of the Choosing Childbirth Act
- 4) \$463,670.00 for the operation of the Dental Loan Repayment Program
- 5) \$1.9 million to be disbursed to health centers authorized by Public Health Services Act
