Impact:	Travel reimbursement and possible administrative costs

Research Analysis

The floor amendment to SB 1102 modifies the Catastrophic Health Emergency Powers Act. The measure:

- Adds that a purpose of the act is to protect civil right and liberties while ensuring public safety,
- Clarifies that the act allows for the management of state property,
- Removes language authorizing local officials during a catastrophic health emergency to provide treatment to affected individuals and separate affected individuals from the population at large,
- Allows the Governor during a catastrophic health emergency to grant local officials certain authorities,
- Modifies the membership of the Oklahoma Catastrophic Health Emergency Planning Task Force to include three Senate members (two from the majority party and one from the minority party), three House members (two from the majority party and one from the minority party), the director of the Department of Corrections, two law enforcement members, two members from the private sector with disaster relief expertise, and four members from the private business community,
- Requires certain health reporting and investigatory requirements to be activated by a specific executive order from the Governor,
- Requires the Governor to notify the Legislature of requested powers prior to a catastrophic health emergency declaration,
- Requires the Governor to state the requested powers he or she is seeking under an extended catastrophic health emergency,
- Authorizes the State Election Board to promulgate emergency rules, not subject to the Administrative Procedures Act, during a catastrophic health emergency to ensure election integrity while protecting public health.
