Research Analysis

SB1115 allows the State Board of Education to renew the emergency or provisional certificate of an individual who has been employed by a school district for at least two years if the following criteria are met:

- The individual has been granted a provisional or emergency certification for two years
- The individual has not successfully completed the competency exams
- The individual submits a portfolio of their work to the State Board of Education, which shall include progress toward standard certification
- The superintendent of the employing school district submits to the State Board of Education evidence of the district's inability to hire a teacher who holds a standard certificate.

The measure exempts individuals who hold emergency or provisional certificates from being protected under the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990.
