SB 1138 makes an appropriation of \$4 Million to the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission from funds made available to the state by the federal Unemployment Compensation Modernization Transfer.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1138, as engrossed, makes an appropriation of \$4,000,000 to the Employment Security Administration Fund out of funds made available to Oklahoma by the federal Unemployment Compensation Modernization Transfer made on June 25, 2009. These federal funds are held in Oklahoma's Unemployment Trust Fund and can only be used to support Oklahoma's Unemployment Insurance and Employment Services programs, both administered by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission. The federal program requires the legislature to make an appropriation to OESC of these funds before OESC may use them to support its programs.

SB 1138 further directs that the \$4,000,000 appropriation be split equally between the Unemployment Insurance and Employment Services programs. After this appropriation, approximately \$28,000,000 of the original transfer remains.

The appropriation made by SB 1138 is from federal monies to be used solely by OESC, requiring no state contribution. For this reason, SB 1138 has a \$0 negative impact to the state.
