Research Analysis

The second floor amendment for SB 1714 amends the Home Bakery Act of 2013 by renaming it the Homemade Food Freedom Act, increasing the sales limit to \$100,000, and expanding the eligible food types and labeling requirements. The measure allows producers to sell shelf-stable homemade food in stores or directly to consumers, both in-person or through a delivery service; foods requiring temperature control may be sold directly to the consumer. Meat or meat byproducts are not allowed in any form. Producers are exempt from licensing and all requirements of the State Department of Health and the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. Lastly, the measure allows small-scale beekeepers to sell honey or honeycomb through the mail or in person using a representative, if desired.
